College of Education policies to be aware of:

These stipend rates are established by the college and no deviation is expected. Extraordinary circumstances are reviewed on a case by case basis.

An appointment of greater than 50% will require the approval of the Associate Dean.

A student with more than 5 years in their grad program cannot hold an assistantship without the approval of the Associate Dean

Critical Dates - Fall Semester 2011

*Grads appointed Fall or Spring for 53 calendar days or more are eligible for tuition waiver & health benefits.

The daily rate = the biweekly rate /14 days.

Monday, July 11, 2011: Due date for Fall 2011 Assistantship forms to be received by Staffing Services via EBS workflow in order to be processed on time for Payroll.

Friday, July 15, 2011: Due date for department to send student's name and PID via the Graduate Assistant Registrar Coding List to the Registrar Office in time for the tuition waiver to be reflected on the student's bill for Fall 2011.

Specific Identification Charge Assessed per Graduate Assistant per semester

*11-12 lump sum bonus 1.5% for TA, 2.0% for RA & TE. Based on fall appointments in by October and must start 8/16.

It will be based on the fall biweekly stipend x 26 and will be charged to the accounts where the GA is paid.

*\$5,094 per semester for Fall 2011 and Spring 2012 (bi-weekly amounts will be based on SAP proration for 10 periods per semester, with the 1st period prorated based on number of semester days in the pay period. Spring semester will also prorate based on number of days.)

*\$1,983 per semester for Summer 2012 (bi-weekly amounts will be based on SAP proration)

*The health portion of the SI charge for Fall and Spring per semester is \$991 (\$100 per biweekly pay) with the remaining \$4,103 (\$416 per biweekly pay) covering the tuition. There is no health charge for summer semester.

*Fringes for Health (object code 6516) and Tuition and Fees (object code 6230) will be charged with each bi-weekly payroll.
